Priority technical objectives

Reduction of virus load and circulation in poultry and domestic birds

- ensure early detection and transparent notification
- guarantee rapid response
 - confinement
 - humane stamping out
 - rapid confirmation of suspects
 - appropriate use of vaccination

Priority technical objectives

Strict implementation of international standards on:

- Implementation of standards for governance and quality of Veterinary Services
- Safety of movements of animals and animal products
- Zoning and compartmentalisation
- Implementation of surveillance guidelines
- Compliance with notification obligations
- Humane methods for depopulation for disease control purpose
- OIE standards on laboratory procedures and vaccines manufacturing

Partnerships

Priority partnerships

- with FAO
- with WHO
- with private sector representatives
- with donors
- with governments through OIE Member Countries Representatives (CVO)
- between veterinary and medical authorities
- with NGOs

National

Global level

- Global forum for alliances and partnerships
 - Global quality centre
 - Improvement of governance and veterinary policies
 - New alliances between public and private sector, international organisations (FAO) and donors
 - Support regional programs mirroring after Global level activities
 - Global fund for animal health coordinated by the OIE in association with partners
 - Support to OFFLU and other partnerships

Mechanisms

Regional level

- Capacity building for policy makers and private sector
- Quality centres for support to countries
 - evaluation and audits of Veterinary Services
 - preparation of national projects
 - in the framework of GF-TADs mechanisms
 - 8 OIE regional representations and offices worldwide

National level

- National project preparation with the support from Regional Quality Centres
- Evaluation of quality of Veterinary Services using both internal and external audits
- Creation of national committee of stakeholders
- Promulgation of new governance and policies design complying with OIE standards and using private sector input

National level (cont.)

- Technical and economical evaluation of appropriate investments in infrastructures
- Setting up compensation funds for farmers and with insurance companies
- Support to farmers veterinarians and industry: organisation and training
- Support to infrastructure investments, including laboratories
- Implementation of actions in direct coordination between government and donors
- FAO support
